The Forklift Truck

- **Examination Criteria:**
Hydraulic hoses & connections
Rams & seals
Power sources – Battery leads & fuel
Configuration of fork & end stops
Lift chain & individual links / pins
Percentage wear
Jib & attachments
Indicators – tyres warning device (horn etc)
All controls
Hydraulic oil & brake fluid
Cockpit, seat & protection cabin
Reporting procedures

Employees who are required to carry out in-house pre-use and/or LOLER inspections every 12 or 6 months on Fork Lift Trucks

DETAILS

Delegates who attend this course must be fully qualified engineers. This course is only designed for employees to carry out In-house Inspection and certify Forklift Trucks every 12 months or six months if used for man-riding.
